## A BILL

- To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to promulgate regulations establishing emission standards for emissions of greenhouse gases from aircraft, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Clean Skies Act".
  - 5 SEC. 2. AIRCRAFT GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION STAND-
  - 6 ARDS.
  - 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 18 months after
- 8 the date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of

- 1 the Environmental Protection Agency shall promulgate
- 2 final regulations establishing emission standards for emis-
- 3 sions of greenhouse gases from both new and in-service
- 4 aircraft pursuant to section 231 of the Clean Air Act (42
- 5 U.S.C. 7571).
- 6 (b) Soliciting Comments.—In proposing such reg-
- 7 ulations, the Administrator of the Environmental Protec-
- 8 tion Agency shall solicit comments on—
- 9 (1) the minimum greenhouse gas emission
- standards established by the International Civil
- 11 Aviation Organization; and
- 12 (2) relative to such minimum standards, green-
- house gas emission standards that would achieve
- 14 greater reductions in greenhouse gas emissions.
