- 1 Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Secretary (c) (1) 2 shall adopt regulations to govern the policies and management of correctional facilities in 3 the Department in accordance with Title 10, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article. 4 (2)Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply to a guideline pertaining 5 to the routine internal management of correctional facilities in the Division of Correction. 6 Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the Secretary (3)(i) 7 shall adopt regulations that provide for a requirement that: 8 1. a correctional officer hired on or after October 1, [2007] 9 2020, for employment in any unit of the Division of Correction shall be at least [21] 19 10 years old; and 2. 11 a correctional officer hired on or after October 1, [2008] 2020, for employment in any unit of the Division of Pretrial Detention and Services or the 12 Patuxent Institution shall be at least [21] 19 years old. 13 14 The regulations adopted under subparagraph (i) of this (ii) paragraph shall exempt any honorably discharged veteran or reserve member of the United 15 16 States armed forces from the minimum age requirement.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2020.
