FOR the purpose of establishing the Office of the Environmental and Natural Resources Ombudsman; requiring the Office of the Attorney General to provide office space and staff for the Ombudsman in a certain manner; providing for the appointment, qualifications, term, and salary of the Ombudsman; requiring the Ombudsman to be a full-time State employee; requiring the Ombudsman to receive and process complaints involving suspected environmental and natural resources violations in a certain manner; requiring the Ombudsman to maintain and update certain information involving suspected environmental and natural resources violations in consultation with the Department of the Environment, the Department of Natural Resources, and the Department of Agriculture in a certain manner; requiring the Ombudsman to update a certain individual who has submitted a complaint under certain provisions of this Act under certain circumstances; requiring the Ombudsman to develop and maintain a certain website in conjunction with the Department of the Environment, the Department of Natural Resources, and the Department of Agriculture to provide certain information; requiring certain information posted on a certain website to be kept in a certain manner; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Office of the Environmental and Natural Resources Ombudsman.
