 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Flagstaff Federal Re-
 - 5 version Relief Act".

1 SEC. 2. RELEASE OF FEDERAL REVERSIONARY INTEREST,

- 2 FLAGSTAFF, ARIZONA.
- 3 Any land (including the parcel of land located in the
- 4 City of Flagstaff, Arizona, owned by Win Oil Company,
- 5 Inc., and more particularly described in the deed recorded
- 6 in Coconino County, Arizona, on November 11, 1998, as
- 7 document number 98–44431) that is subject to a Federal
- 8 reversionary interest pursuant to the Act of July 27, 1866
- 9 (14 Stat. 292, chapter 278), shall no longer be subject
- 10 to the Federal reversionary interest described in that Act.
