Mr. Joyce of Pennsylvania introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Small Business

A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to develop a training curriculum on category management, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Small Business Cat-
- 5 egory Management Training Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CATEGORY MANAGEMENT TRAINING.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 8 months after the
- 8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of
- 9 the Small Business Administration, in coordination with
- 10 the Administrator of the Office of Federal Procurement

- 1 Policy and any other head of a Federal agency as deter-
- 2 mined by the Administrator, shall develop a training cur-
- 3 riculum on category management for staff of Federal
- 4 agencies with procurement or acquisition responsibilities.
- 5 Such training shall include—
- 6 (1) best practices for purchasing goods and
- 7 services from small business concerns (as defined
- 8 under section 3 of the Small Business Act (15
- 9 U.S.C. 632)); and
- 10 (2) information on avoiding conflicts with the
- 11 requirements of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
- 12 631 et seq.).
- 13 (b) USE OF CURRICULUM.—The Administrator of the
- 14 Small Business Administration—
- 15 (1) shall ensure that staff for Federal agencies
- described in subsection (a) receive the training de-
- scribed in such subsection; and
- 18 (2) may request the assistance of the relevant
- 19 Director of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utili-
- 20 zation (as described in section 15(k) of the Small
- Business Act (15 U.S.C. 644(k))) to carry out the
- requirements of paragraph (1).
- (c) Submission to Congress.—The Administrator
- 24 of the Small Business Administration shall provide a copy
- 25 of the training curriculum developed under subsection (a)

- 1 to the Committee on Small Business of the House of Rep-
- 2 resentatives and the Committee on Small Business and
- 3 Entrepreneurship of the Senate.
- 4 (d) CATEGORY MANAGEMENT DEFINED.—In this
- 5 Act, the term "category management" has the meaning
- 6 given by the Director of the Office of Management and

7 Budget.
