## Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Small Yacht Club License

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a small yacht club alcoholic beverages license in Anne 4 Arundel County; requiring a certain individual to sign an application for the license; 5 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to issue 6 the license for use by a small yacht club that meets certain criteria; specifying that 7 the license authorizes a license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor to club members 8 and guests for on-premises consumption under certain circumstances; specifying the 9 days and hours of sale of alcoholic beverages under the license; notwithstanding any 10 other provision of law, authorizing a license holder to purchase alcoholic beverages 11 from a retail dealer; specifying an annual fee for the license; and generally relating 12 to alcoholic beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County.
