A BILL

To prohibit the flying of any flag other than the United States flag over United States diplomatic and consular posts, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Old Glory Only Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FLYING OF CERTAIN FLAGS OVER
2	UNITED STATES DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR
3	POSTS.
4	The Secretary of State shall ensure that no United
5	States diplomatic or consular post flies any flag other than
6	the United States flag over such post.
