JOINT RESOLUTION

Making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2017, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*

2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2017 (division

4 C of Public Law 114–223) is further amended by—

5 (1) striking the date specified in section 106(3)

6 and inserting “May 5, 2017”; and

7 (2) inserting after section 201 the following

8 new section:

9 “SEC. 202. (a) This section may be cited as the ‘Fur-

10 ther Continued Health Benefits for Miners Act’.

1 “(b) Section 402(h)(2)(C)(ii) of the Surface Mining
2 Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 (30 U.S.C.
3 1232(h)(2)(C)(ii)) is amended—

4 “(1) in subclause (II), by striking ‘April 30,
5 2017’ and inserting ‘May 5, 2017’;

6 “(2) in subclause (II)(aa), by striking ‘the Con-
7 tinued Health Benefits for Miners Act’ and inserting
8 ‘the Further Continued Health Benefits for Miners
9 Act’; and

10 “(3) by adding at the end the following: ‘For
11 purposes of subclause (II)(aa), a beneficiary enrolled
12 in the Plan as of the date of the enactment of the
13 Further Continued Health Benefits for Miners Act
14 shall be deemed to have been eligible to receive
15 health benefits under the Plan on January 1, 2017.’.

16 “(c) The provisions of section 167(d) of Public Law
17 114–223 (as added by Public Law 114–254) shall apply
18 to this section.”.
