- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Providing Resources,
- 5 Officers, and Technology To Eradicate Cyber Threats to

1 Our Children Act of 2017" or the "PROTECT Our Children Act of 2017". SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE NATIONAL INTERNET 4 CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE 5 PROGRAM. Title I of the PROTECT Our Children Act of 2008 6 (42 U.S.C. 17601 et seq.) is amended— 8 (1) in section 105(h) (42 U.S.C. 17615(h)), by striking "2016" and inserting "2022"; and 9 section 10 (2)in 107(a)(10)(42)U.S.C. 11 17617(a)(10)), by striking "fiscal year 2018" and inserting "each of fiscal years 2018 through 2022".
