A BILL

To exempt breastfeeding women from jury duty, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Breastfeeding Mothers
- 5 Jury Duty Exclusion Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. JURY DUTY EXEMPTION FOR BREASTFEEDING
- 7 **WOMEN.**
- 8 (a) Courts of the United States.—Section 1866
- 9 of title 28, United States Code, is amended—

1	(1) in subsection (c), by inserting after "Except
2	as provided" the following: "in subsection (h) of this
3	section,"; and
4	(2) by adding at the end the following:
5	"(h) An individual who is a breastfeeding woman
6	summoned for jury service shall be excused by the court,
7	or by the clerk under supervision of the court if the court's
8	jury selection plan so authorizes, upon the individual's re-
9	quest.".
10	(b) Courts of the District of Columbia.—Sec-
11	tion 11–1908(b), District of Columbia Official Code, is
12	amended—
13	(1) by striking "or (4)" and inserting "(4)";
14	and
15	(2) by striking the period at the end of the first
16	sentence and inserting the following: "; or (5) ex-
17	cluded by the Court upon the request of the indi-
18	vidual if the individual is a breastfeeding woman.".
