Ms. ERNST introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds for purchasing dogs and cats from wet markets in China, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON THE PURCHASE OF DOGS 4 AND CATS FROM WET MARKETS IN CHINA 5 USING FEDERAL FUNDS. 6 (a) DEFINITION OF WET MARKET.—In this section, the term "wet market" means a marketplace-7 8 (1) where fresh meat, fish, and live animals are 9 bought, sold, and slaughtered; and

(2) that is not regulated under any standard ized sanitary or health inspection processes that
 meet applicable standards required for similar estab lishments in the United States, as determined by the
 Secretary of Agriculture.

6 (b) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other provi7 sion of law, no Federal funds made available by any law
8 may be used by the Federal Government, or any recipient
9 of the Federal funds under a contract, grant, subgrant,
10 or other assistance, to purchase from a wet market in
11 China—

12 (1) a live cat, dog, or other animal;

13 (2) a carcass, any part, or any item containing14 any part of a cat, dog, or other animal; or

15 (3) any other animal product.
