BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Atlanta, approved April 15, 1996
(Ga. L. 1996, p. 4469), as amended, is amended by designating the current text of
Section 1-105 as subsection (a) and by adding a new subsection (b) to read as follows:

"(b) On and after the effective date of this subsection, the corporate boundaries of the City
of Atlanta shall no longer contain Fulton County tax parcels 17 0202 LL0340 and 17 0202
LL0480 as such tax parcels existed on the tax rolls and tax maps of Fulton County for the

13 year 2016."

SECTION 2.

15 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which

16 it is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval, provided that an Act

17 to annex the territory described in this Act into the City of Sandy Springs is passed in the

- 18 2017 regular session of the General Assembly and becomes effective on the same date.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
