3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL.**

7 Planning Area Reform” (81 Fed. Reg. 93448 (December

1 20, 2016)) shall have no force or effect, and any regula-
2 tion revised by that rule shall be applied as if that rule
3 had not been issued.

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
