A BILL

To prohibit the use of eminent domain for the construction or expansion of a natural gas pipe line through land conserved by certain land trusts and local governments, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Our Con-
5 served Lands Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON THE USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN.**

7 Section 7(h) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.
8 717f(h)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “When” and inserting “(1)
2 When”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following new
4 paragraph:

5 “(2) Beginning on January 1, 2022, notwithstanding
6 paragraph (1), a holder of a certificate of public conven-
7 ience and necessity may not exercise the right of eminent
8 domain to acquire land or other property necessary to con-
9 struct, operate, or maintain a pipe line for the transpor-
10 tation of natural gas, or any station or equipment nec-
11 essary to the proper operation of such pipe line, any part
12 of which will be located on land that is—

13 “(A) subject to a conservation easement or
14 other conservation-related restriction by an organiza-
15 tion described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
16 Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from taxation
17 under section 501(a) of such Code;

18 “(B) owned by or deeded to an organization de-
19 scribed in subparagraph (A) for the purpose of con-
20 servation;

21 “(C) subject to a conservation easement or
22 other conservation-related restriction by a munici-
23 pality, county, or other division of local government;
24 or

1 “(D) owned by or deeded to a municipality,
2 county, or other division or subdivision of local gov-
3 ernment for the purpose of conservation.”.

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
