- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	(A)	IN THIS SECTION, "CIVIL PROCEEDING" INCLUDES:
18		(1) ANY PART OF A CIVIL ACTION; AND
19		(2) ANY PART OF A CIVIL APPELLATE PROCEEDING.
20	(B)	ON MOTION OF ANY PARTY, A COURT SHALL CONTINUE A CIVIL

21 PROCEEDING IF ALL PARTIES AGREE TO THE CONTINUANCE.



1 (C) WHEN GRANTING A CONTINUANCE UNDER THIS SECTION, A COURT MAY 2 ASSESS COSTS AND EXPENSES OCCASIONED BY THE CONTINUANCE IN ACCORDANCE 3 WITH THE MARYLAND RULES.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2017.
