 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Public Housing Fire

5 Safety Act".

6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

- 7 In this Act—
- 8 (1) the term "automatic sprinkler system" has 9 the meaning given the term in section 31(a) of the

3	(2) the term "Capital Fund" means the Capital
4	Fund established under section 9(d) of the United

9	property, as defined in section 31(c)(2)(A)(ii) of

16	(4) the terms "public housing" and "public
17	housing agency" have the meanings given those

19	Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437a(b)); and
20	(5) the term "Secretary" means the Secretary

22	SEC. 3. INSPECTIONS OF PUBLIC HOUSING.
23	(a) IN GENERAL.—With respect to inspections of
24	public housing conducted by the Secretary, including
25	through the Real Estate Assessment Center, the Secretary

shall report on the presence or absence of automatic sprin kler systems in the public housing project.

3 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 3 years after the date 4 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall, based on 5 inspections of public housing conducted during the 3-year period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act, sub-6 7 mit to Congress a report on the presence or absence of 8 automatic sprinkler systems in public housing, in par-9 ticular in exempted public housing projects, which shall 10 include recommendations to improve fire safety in exempted public housing projects. 11

(c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a public housing agency
to install an automatic sprinkler system in an exempted
public housing project.

16 SEC. 4. GRANT PROGRAM TO RETROFIT PUBLIC HOUSING

WITH AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER SYSTEMS.

(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary shall establish
a competitive grant program under which the Secretary
shall award grants to public housing agencies to install
automatic sprinkler systems in exempted public housing
projects.

(b) LIMITATION.—A public housing agency may not
use amounts received under this section to install automatic sprinkler systems in a rebuilt multifamily property,

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as defined in section 31(c)(2)(A)(iii) of the Federal Fire
 Prevention and Control Act of 1974 (15 U.S.C.
 3 2227(c)(2)(A)(iii)).

4 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In addi5 tion to amounts appropriated to the Capital Fund under
6 any other provision of law, there is authorized to be appro7 priated to the Capital Fund \$25,000,000 for each of fiscal
8 years 2020 through 2029 to carry out this section.

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
