A BILL

To prohibit Federal funding to the Wuhan Institute of Virology.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Defund the Wuhan
- 5 Institute of Virology Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING TO THE

- 2 WUHAN INSTITUTE OF VIROLOGY.
- 3 (a) In General.—No funds authorized or appro-
- 4 priated by Federal law may be made available for any pur-
- 5 pose to the Wuhan Institute of Virology.
- 6 (b) GAO STUDY AND REPORT.—Not later than 2
- 7 years after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
- 8 Comptroller General of the United States shall conduct
- 9 a study, and submit to Congress a report, on the amount
- 10 of Federal funds awarded or indirectly given to Wuhan
- 11 Institute of Virology or researchers affiliated with Wuhan
- 12 Institute of Virology, during the 15-year period preceding
- 13 such date of enactment were provided, whether purposely
- 14 or inadvertently, to the People's Republic of China, Chi-
- 15 nese Communist Party, or the Wuhan Institute of Virol-
- 16 ogy, or any agency or instrumentality thereof.
