### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

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### **Community Colleges – State Funding – Revision**

- FOR the purpose of specifying that a certain appropriation calculated under the Senator John A. Cade Funding Formula and a certain appropriation for Baltimore City Community College include appropriations, regardless of where they are budgeted, designated for the general operation of 4-year public institutions of higher education

## Article – Education

(a) The formula used for the distribution of funds to the community colleges inthe State shall be known as the Senator John A. Cade Funding Formula.

Sellinger 10 Program under Title 17 of this article in the same fiscal year.

14(I)NONCAPITAL appropriations from the Higher Education15Investment Fund; AND

16 **(II)** APPROPRIATIONS, REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY ARE 17BUDGETED, DESIGNATED FOR THE GENERAL OPERATION OF 4-YEAR PUBLIC 18 **INSTITUTIONS** OF HIGHER **EDUCATION** IN THE STATE. **INCLUDING** 19 PERSONNEL-RELATED APPROPRIATIONS.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2020.
