- 4 31-5-915 or 31-5-923, the driver of every other vehicle, as
- 5 soon as it is safe:

- 7 (i) When driving on an interstate highway or
- 8 other highway with two (2) or more lanes traveling in the
- 9 direction of the parked vehicle shall merge into the lane
- 10 farthest from the vehicle, except when otherwise directed
- 11 by a police officer;

- 13 (ii) When driving on a two (2) lane road with a
- 14 posted speed limit of forty-five (45) miles per hour or
- 15 greater, shall slow to a speed that is twenty (20) miles
- 16 per hour less than the posted speed limit, except when
- 17 otherwise directed by a police officer.
