3	The Automobile National Heritage Area Act (Public

6	(1) in section 109, by striking "September 30,
7	2021" and inserting "September 30, 2025"; and
8	(2) in section 110(a)—
9	(A) in the second sentence, by striking
10	"Not more than a total of \$10,000,000" and
11	inserting the following:
12	"(2) LIMITATION ON TOTAL APPROPRIA-
13	TIONS.—Not more than a total of \$12,000,000";
14	and
15	(B) by striking the subsection designation
16	and heading and all that follows through
17	"There are" in the first sentence and inserting
18	the following:
19	"(a) Annual Appropriations; Limitation on
20	TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS.—
21	"(1) ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS.—There is".
