Mr. Rounds submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

RESOLUTION

To express the sense of the Senate on United States-Israel cooperation on precision-guided munitions.

1 Resolved, That it is the sense of the Senate that— 2 (1) the Department of Defense has cooperated 3 extensively with Israel to assist in the procurement 4 of precision-guided munitions, and such cooperation 5 represents an important example of robust United 6 States support for Israel; 7 (2) to the extent practicable, the Secretary of 8 Defense should take further measures to expedite 9 deliveries of precision-guided munitions to Israel; 10 and

1	(3) regularized annual purchases of precision-
2	guided munitions by Israel, in accordance with exist-
3	ing requirements and practices regarding the export
4	of defense articles and defense services, coordinated
5	with the United States Air Force annual purchase of
6	precision-guided munitions, would enhance the secu-
7	rity of both the United States and Israel by—
8	(A) promoting a more efficient use of de-
9	fense resources by taking advantage of econo-
10	mies of scale;
11	(B) enabling the United States and Israel
12	to address crisis requirements for precision-

- (B) enabling the United States and Israel to address crisis requirements for precisionguided munitions in a timely and flexible manner; and
- (C) encouraging the defense industrial base to maintain routine production lines of precision-guided munitions.
