SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (b) (1) (I) A severance tax of [\$1] \$2 per bushel shall be levied [upon] ON every bushel of oysters caught within the limits of the natural oyster bars of the State exclusive of the Potomac River.

20 (II) The oyster buyer or receiver shall pay the tax to the Department 21 for deposit to the credit of the Fisheries Research and Development Fund.

22 **(2) (1)** This section does not prevent any person licensed to catch oysters in the State from selling [his] **THE PERSON'S** oysters in the shell directly to a consumer in
