CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to union security agreements; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) To encourage labor peace, it is the policy of the State of Oregon to allow private sector labor organizations and employers to enter into union security agreements to the full extent allowed by federal law.

(2) It is the intent of the Legislative Assembly in enacting section 3 of this 2017 Act to exercise the limited authority reserved to states under section 14(b) of the National Labor Relations Act.

SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapters 661 to 663.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> An employer or labor organization anywhere in this state may execute and apply an agreement requiring membership in a labor organization as a condition of employment to the full extent allowed by federal law.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.
