## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Gold Star

5 Spouses Act of 2019".

# SEC. 2. INTERIM APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE COAST GUARD RETIRED SERVICEMAN'S FAMILY PROTEC TION AND SURVIVOR BENEFITS PLANS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are hereby appropriated, 5 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for each fiscal year after fiscal year 2018, such 6 7 sums as necessary for payment of the Coast Guard Re-8 tired Serviceman's Family Protection and Survivor Bene-9 fits Plans, as are described in the provision regarding Coast Guard retired pay in title II of division F of the 10 Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2018 (Public Law 115– 11 141; 132 Stat. 348), at a rate for operations and under 12 13 the terms and conditions provided by the most recent law making full-year appropriations for such Coast Guard Re-14 tired Serviceman's Family Protection and Survivor Bene-15 fits Plans. 16

(b) EFFECT OF ENACTMENT OF SUBSEQUENT AP-17 PROPRIATIONS.-If an appropriation for such Coast 18 19 Guard Retired Serviceman's Family Protection and Survivor Benefits Plans, or a general appropriation bill pro-20 21 viding appropriations for the Coast Guard without provi-22 sion for such Coast Guard Retired Serviceman's Family 23 Protection and Survivor Benefits Plans, is enacted into 24 law on any date after the date of the enactment of this 25 Act that provides for appropriations during a fiscal year following the expenditure of funds during such fiscal year
pursuant to this Act—

3 (1) such expenditure shall be charged to such4 appropriation (if any); and

5 (2) appropriations made available for such fis-6 cal year pursuant to this Act shall not be available 7 after the date of enactment of such appropriation or 8 general appropriation bill.

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
