12 Tourism and Labor; Transportation; and Veterans, Military Affairs, and Public Protection
13 committees. He also serves on the Administrative Regulations Review Subcommittee and
14 the Program Review and Investigations Committee; and

15 WHEREAS, Senator Clark is rightfully honored on this day for his exemplary
16 service to the Commonwealth as a member of the Senate; and

17 WHEREAS, Senator Clark's tireless work on behalf of his constituents is justly
18 acknowledged, and for his fourteen years of service to this body, for the countless hours

20 human being of the first order, he is commended and granted best wishes as he begins a
