- 4 CENTER IN CARES ACT.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and
- 6 Economic Security Act is amended by striking the item
- 7 relating to the John F. Kennedy Center for the Per-
- 8 forming Arts.

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) shall take ef-
- 2 fect as if included in the enactment of the Coronavirus

3 Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act.
