- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1834(m)(7) of the Social

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by

10SEC. 3. STUDY AND REPORT ON UTILIZATION OF MENTAL11HEALTH SERVICES FURNISHED THROUGH12TELEHEALTH.

Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall submit to Congress a report on the utilization of mental health services furnished through telehealth under section 1834(m)(7) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m(m)(7)), that includes any recommendations of the Secretary regarding—

20 (1) fraud or abuse prevention with respect to21 such services; and

(2) additional funding that the Office of Inspector General of the Department of Health and
Human Services may require for purposes of conducting audits, investigations, and other oversight

1 and enforcement activities with respect to the fur-

2 nishing of such services.
