3 **Beer, Wine, and Liquor License**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Harford County to
5 issue a Class GCR (golf course restaurant) beer, wine, and liquor license in
6 accordance with certain requirements; providing for the days and hours of sale for
7 the license; establishing an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic
8 beverages licenses in Harford County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

This title applies only in Harford County.

(A) THERE IS A CLASS GCR (GOLF COURSE RESTAURANT) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A CLASS GCR LICENSE TO THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A GOLF COURSE THAT:

(1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC;

(2) IS OPERATED FOR PROFIT;

(3) HAS A MINIMUM OF 18 HOLES; AND

(4) HAS A KITCHEN FACILITY THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.

(C) (1) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LAND AND IN THE BUILDINGS, INCLUDING THE CLUBHOUSE, USED FOR GOLFING PURPOSES AND FOR NON-GOLF-RELATED EVENTS.

(2) A PATRON NEED NOT BE SEATED TO BE SERVED.

(3) THE LICENSE IS LIMITED TO ON-PREMISES SALES ONLY.

(D) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS AS SET OUT FOR A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE UNDER § 22-2004 OF THIS TITLE.

(E) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$3,500.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
