BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 7-103(c)Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 7-103.(c) (1) The following days are public school holidays: (i) Thanksgiving Day and the day after; Christmas Eve and from then through January 1; (ii) (iii) Martin Luther King, Jr. Day;
