- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Local Government
- 16 **1–1314.**
- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "AMATEUR RADIO" MEANS THE USE OF A RADIO
- 18 FREQUENCY SPECTRUM FOR PURPOSES OF NONCOMMERCIAL EXCHANGE OF
- 19 MESSAGES, WIRELESS EXPERIMENTATION, SELF-TRAINING, PRIVATE RECREATION,
- 20 RADIOSPORT, CONTESTING, OR EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION BY A DULY
- 21 AUTHORIZED PERSON INTERESTED IN RADIOELECTRIC PRACTICE WITH A PURELY
- 22 PERSONAL AIM AND WITHOUT PECUNIARY INTEREST.
- 23 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES.

- 1 (C) It is the intent of the General Assembly to codify the 2 Provisions of 47 C.F.R. § 97.15 concerning the Federal Communications
- 3 COMMISSION'S PREEMPTION OF LOCAL ORDINANCES REGULATING AMATEUR RADIO
- 4 STATION ANTENNA STRUCTURES.
- 5 (D) A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE REGULATING AMATEUR RADIO 6 STATION ANTENNA STRUCTURES:
- 7 (1) MAY NOT PRECLUDE AMATEUR RADIO COMMUNICATIONS;
- 8 (2) SHALL REASONABLY ACCOMMODATE AMATEUR RADIO 9 COMMUNICATIONS; AND
- 10 (3) SHALL CONSTITUTE THE MINIMUM PRACTICABLE REGULATION TO ACCOMPLISH THE LEGITIMATE PURPOSE OF THE ORDINANCE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
