- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class M-G beer, wine, and liquor license for use at a municipal golf course in Frederick County; authorizing the Board of License 4 5 Commissioners for Frederick County to issue the license to a manager of a municipal 6 golf course; specifying that the license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, 7 and liquor for on-premises consumption on certain land and facilities used for golfing 8 purposes; authorizing the license holder to designate an agent for certain purposes; 9 providing that the agent shall be considered to be the vendor for certain purposes; 10 authorizing the Board to transfer a license to a different golf course manager under 11 certain circumstances; specifying the hours and days of sale; specifying a certain 12 annual license fee; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally 13 relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Frederick County.
