A BILL

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To improve the effectiveness and available tools of State and tribal child support enforcement agencies, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Strengthening State and 5 Tribal Child Support Enforcement Act". SEC. 2. IMPROVING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF TRIBAL CHILD 6 7 SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES. 8 (a) Improving the Collection of Past-due Child SUPPORT THROUGH STATE AND TRIBAL PARITY IN THE 9 Allowable Use of Tax Information.— 10 11 (1) Amendment to the social security 12 ACT.—Section 464 of the Social Security Act (42 13 U.S.C. 664) is amended by adding at the end the fol-14 lowing: 15 "(d) Applicability to Indian Tribes and Tribal This 16 Organizations Receiving a Grant Under PART.—This section, except for the requirement to dis-17 tribute amounts in accordance with section 457, shall apply 18 to an Indian tribe or tribal organization receiving a grant 19 20 under section 455(f) in the same manner in which this sec-21 tion applies to a State with a plan approved under this 22 part.".
