- * Section 1. AS 45.50.471(b) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:
- 6 (58) violating AS 45.50.476 (prohibited lease provision).
- 7 * Sec. 2. AS 45.50 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 45.50.476. Prohibited lease provision. A lease of space for business use may not include a provision that prohibits or otherwise prevents a party to the lease from
- 11 (1) selling or leasing that party's real property, including an interest in 12 real property, to a person who is not a party to the lease and who intends to use the 13 real property or interest for the operation of a business that is the same as or similar to 14 a business, or part of a business, owned or engaged in by another party to the lease;

1	(2) assisting or facilitating a person who is not a party to the lease to
2	operate a business that is the same as or similar to a business, or part of a business,
3	owned or engaged in by another party to the lease; or
4	(3) engaging, directly or indirectly, by itself or with another person, in
5	a business that is the same as or similar to a business, or part of a business, owned or
6	engaged in by another party to the lease.
