#### **AN ACT**

- To terminate the requirement imposed by the Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for proof of COVID-19 vaccination for foreign travelers, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### SECTION 1. TERMINATING CDC REQUIREMENT FOR PROOF OF COVID-19 VACCINATION FOR FOREIGN TRAVELERS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of the en5 actment of this Act, the air travel vaccination requirement
6 for foreign travelers shall have no force or effect.

7 (b) PROHIBITION ON FUNDING.—Beginning on the
8 date of the enactment of this Act, no Federal funds may
9 be used to administer, implement, or enforce the air travel
10 vaccination requirement for foreign travelers.

(c) AIR TRAVEL VACCINATION REQUIREMENT FOR
FOREIGN TRAVELERS.—In this Act, the term "air travel
vaccination requirement for foreign travelers" refers to the
requirement specified in—

15 (1) the order issued by the Director of the Cen-16 ters for Disease Control and Prevention entitled "Amended Order Implementing Presidential Procla-17 18 mation on Advancing the Safe Resumption of Global 19 Travel During the COVID–19 Pandemic" and pub-20 lished in the Federal Register on April 7, 2022 (87) 21 Fed. Reg. 20405 et seq.), for proof of COVID-19 22 vaccination for air travelers who are covered individ-23 uals (as defined in such order); or

24 (2) any successor or subsequent order of the
25 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention requir26 ing foreign persons traveling by air to show proof of
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COVID-19 vaccination as a condition on entering
 the United States.

#### 3 SEC. 2. REPORT.

4 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact5 ment of this Act, the Director of the Centers for Disease
6 Control and Prevention shall submit a report to Congress
7 on the number of visitors denied entry under the order
8 specified in subsection (c)(1) during the period beginning
9 on April 7, 2022, and ending on the date of the enactment
10 of this Act.

#### 11 SEC. 3. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.

12 Nothing in this Act may be construed to suggest that the provisions of section 1 shall effect the order issued 13 by the Director of the Centers for Disease Control and 14 15 Prevention entitled "Requirements for Negative Pre-Departure COVID-19 Test Results or Documentation of Re-16 covery from COVID–19 for Aircraft Passengers Traveling 17 to the United States From the People's Republic of 18 China" and published in the Federal Register on January 19 20 5, 2023 (88 Fed. Reg. 864) for proof of negative pre-de-21 parture COVID-19 test results or documentation of recov-22 ery from COVID–19 for aircraft passengers traveling to 23 the United States from the People's Republic of China or departing from a designated airport if such passenger has 24

1 been in the People's Republic of China within the 10 days

2 prior to departure for the United States.
