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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.21, as
15	amended by Section 2, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2019,
16	Section 1000.21), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1000.21. A. 1. There is hereby created the Oklahoma
18	Uniform Building Code Commission within the Construction Industries
19	Board which shall consist of <del>eleven (11)</del> <u>thirteen (13)</u> members, <del>nine</del>
20	eleven of whom shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice
21	and consent of the Senate as follows:
22	a. one member who is a general contractor from a
23	statewide organization that represents residential
24	construction,
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- b. one member who is a general contractor from a statewide organization that represents commercial construction,
- 4 c. one member who is a contractor from a statewide 5 organization that represents electrical contractors,
  - d. one member who is a contractor from a statewide
    organization that represents plumbing contractors,
    e. one member who is a contractor from a statewide
  - organization that represents heating and cooling contractors,
  - f. <u>one member who is a contractor from a statewide</u> organization that represents mechanical engineers,
- 13 one member who is a local-level regulator/inspector g. 14 who is a member of a statewide organization that is 15 exempt from taxation under federal law and designated 16 pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue 17 Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 170(a), who has represented 18 municipalities and had statutory functions for 19 municipalities for at least fifteen (15) years prior 20 to November 1, 2005,

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<u>h.</u> one member who is a Certified Building Official employed by a political subdivision,

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- 1 <u>i.</u> one member who is a licensed architect from a 2 statewide organization that represents architects, and 3 <del>i.</del>
- <u>j.</u> one member who is from the insurance industry with
   knowledge of building codes and experience in property
   loss mitigation, and
  - <u>k.</u> one member who is a licensed mechanical engineer from
     a state-recognized professional engineering firm.

9 2. The members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four
10 (4) years, beginning July 1, 2009. The initial appointment of the
11 members added by this act shall be made within ninety (90) days of
12 the effective date of this act. A full term of office for purposes
13 of determining term limits provided in subsection C of this section
14 shall be the completion of a full four-year term of appointment.

B. The remaining two members of the Commission shall be the State Fire Marshal, or a designee, and an appointee of the Construction Industries Board.

C. Appointed members shall continue in office until a successor is appointed by the Governor, notwithstanding the term limitations. No appointed member shall serve more than two consecutive full fouryear terms; provided, such a member shall be eligible to serve until a successor is appointed, and such member may be reappointed after a two-year absence from the Commission. The Governor shall fill all vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as the original

7 D. Whenever a member of the Commission is absent from more than 8 one-half (1/2) of all meetings of the governing body, regular and 9 special, held within any period of twelve (12) consecutive months, 10 the member shall thereupon cease to hold office by operation of law. 11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. 12 SECTION 3.
