To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
SECTION 1. EXTENSION.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period 4 5 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-6 7 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 12642, the 8 Commission may, at the request of the licensee for the 9 project, and after reasonable notice, in accordance with 10 the good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements of that section and the Commission's procedures 11 under that section, extend the time period during which 12 13 the licensee is required to commence the construction of the project for up to 3 consecutive 2-year periods from 14 15 the date of the expiration of the extension originally issued by the Commission. 16

17 (b) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the 18 period required for commencement of construction of the 19 project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the 20 date of the enactment of this Act, the Commission may 21 reinstate the license effective as of the date of its expira-22 tion and the first extension authorized under subsection 23 (a) shall take effect on the date of such expiration.
