BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

- 7 Code Section 20-2-2114 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to qualifications
- 8 for the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship Program, is amended by revising paragraph (3)
- 9 of subsection (a) as follows:
- 10 "(3) The student:
- 11 (A) Has spent the prior school year in attendance at a Georgia public school; provided,
- 12 however, that this requirement shall not apply if:
- 13 (i) The the student's parent is an active duty military service member stationed in
- 14 Georgia within the previous year; or
- 15 (ii) The student previously qualified for a scholarship pursuant to this article; and
- (B) Has an Individualized Education Program written in accordance with federal and 16
- 17 state laws and regulations; provided, however, that the State Board of Education shall
- be authorized to require a local board of education to expedite the development of an 18
- Individualized Education Program and to waive the prior school year requirement 19
- 20 contained in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, in its sole discretion, on a case-by-case
- basis for specific medical needs of the student upon the request of a parent or guardian in accordance with state board procedures. If an expedited Individualized Education 22
- 23 Program is required by the state board pursuant to this subparagraph, the state board
- 24 may additionally require such expedited process to be completed prior to the beginning
- of the school year. The State Board of Education shall provide an annual report by 25

December 31 of each year through December 31, 2015, regarding the number of waivers approved pursuant to this paragraph to the General Assembly;"
