# 1SEC. 2. REPEAL OF THE PATIENT PROTECTION AND AF-2FORDABLE CARE ACT AND THE HEALTH3CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT4OF 2010.

5 (a) PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE
6 ACT.—Effective October 1, 2019, the Patient Protection
7 and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148) is re8 pealed, and the provisions of law amended or repealed by
9 such Act are restored or revived as if such Act had not
10 been enacted.

11 (b) HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILI-12 ATION ACT OF 2010.—Effective October 1, 2019, the 13 Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 14 (Public Law 111–152) is repealed, and the provisions of 15 law amended or repealed by such Act are restored or re-16 vived as if such Act had not been enacted.

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
