A BILL

To repeal the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act
of 2010.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Responsible Path to
5 Full Obamacare Repeal Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF THE PATIENT PROTECTION AND AF-**
2 **FORDABLE CARE ACT AND THE HEALTH**
3 **CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT**
4 **OF 2010.**

5 (a) PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE
6 ACT.—Effective October 1, 2019, the Patient Protection
7 and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148) is re-
8 pealed, and the provisions of law amended or repealed by
9 such Act are restored or revived as if such Act had not
10 been enacted.

11 (b) HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILI-
12 ATION ACT OF 2010.—Effective October 1, 2019, the
13 Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010
14 (Public Law 111–152) is repealed, and the provisions of
15 law amended or repealed by such Act are restored or re-
16 vived as if such Act had not been enacted.

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
