BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

In Fayette County, the Legislature, by general or local law, may place the judge of probate on a salary and provide for the fees, commissions, allowances, and percentages collected by the judge of probate to be paid into the county treasury from which his or her salary is paid. This amendment is retroactive and any local law applicable to Fayette County placing the judge of probate on a salary is ratified and confirmed and any salary paid to the judge of probate prior to the adoption of this amendment is ratified and confirmed.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Section 284 and Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284 and Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

following description of the substance or subject matter of 1 the proposed constitutional amendment: 2 3 "Relating to Fayette County; to authorize the Legislature to place the judge of probate on a salary and 4 provide for the fees, commissions, allowances, and percentages 5 collected by the judge of probate to be deposited in the 6 county treasury.
