A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to issue a final rule relating to the delisting of the gray wolf under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Wild Game
5 and Livestock Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ISSUANCE OF FINAL RULE RELATING TO THE**
7 **DELISTING OF THE GRAY WOLF.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the
9 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior

1 shall issue as a final rule the proposed rule entitled “En-
2 dangered and Threatened Wildlife and Plants; Removing
3 the Gray Wolf (*Canis lupus*) From the List of Endangered
4 and Threatened Wildlife” (84 Fed. Reg. 9648 (March 15,
5 2019)) without regard to any other provision of law (in-
6 cluding regulations) that applies to the issuance of that
7 rule.

8 (b) EXEMPTION OF JUDICIAL REVIEW.—This section
9 and the issuance of the rule under subsection (a) shall not
10 be subject to judicial review.

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
