## A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to issue a final rule relating to the delisting of the gray wolf under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American Wild Game
- 5 and Livestock Protection Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. ISSUANCE OF FINAL RULE RELATING TO THE
- 7 DELISTING OF THE GRAY WOLF.
- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the
- 9 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior

- 1 shall issue as a final rule the proposed rule entitled "En-
- 2 dangered and Threatened Wildlife and Plants; Removing
- 3 the Gray Wolf (Canis lupus) From the List of Endangered
- 4 and Threatened Wildlife" (84 Fed. Reg. 9648 (March 15,
- 5 2019)) without regard to any other provision of law (in-
- 6 cluding regulations) that applies to the issuance of that
- 7 rule.
- 8 (b) Exemption of Judicial Review.—This section
- 9 and the issuance of the rule under subsection (a) shall not
- 10 be subject to judicial review.
