8 data processing technicians; authorizing county to

11 cap; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 377, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 377. The board of county commissioners of any county
16 may employ a competent information technology (IT) staff and a data
17 processing technician, who shall perform the duties of IT management
18 or data processing management as prescribed and directed by the
19 board of county commissioners, ~~and such data processing technician~~
20 ~~shall not be employed beyond the term of office of the board of~~
21 ~~county commissioners employing him.~~ The said IT staff and data
22 processing technician shall receive as compensation ~~a salary~~
23 salaries to be fixed by the board of county commissioners for ~~his~~
24 their services, to be paid out of the general operating fund of the

county. The compensations of the ~~director and such personnel~~ IT staff and data processing technician shall not be governed by the "Comprehensive Salary Code".

The IT staff and data processing technician shall be covered by the county blanket bond.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
