- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13	Article – Alcoholic Beverages

- 15 To qualify for a direct wine shipper's permit, an applicant shall be:
- 16 (1) a person licensed outside the State to engage in the manufacture of 17 wine **THAT DIRECTLY ENGAGES IN THE MANUFACTURE OF WINE**; or
- 18 (2) a holder of a Class 3 manufacturer's license or a Class 4 manufacturer's19 license.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2017.
