- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Education
- 19 4–107.

20 (a) Each county board shall hold an annual meeting on or as near as possible to 21 the second Tuesday in July, except that:

(1) In Allegany County, the annual meeting shall be held on the second
 Tuesday in January;

1 (2) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE 2 HELD ON OR AS NEAR AS POSSIBLE TO THE FIRST WEDNESDAY IN DECEMBER;

3 [(2)] (3) In Montgomery County, the annual meeting shall be held on or 4 before January 10;

5 [(3)] (4) In Prince George's County, the annual meeting shall be held on 6 the first Monday in December;

[(4)] (5) In St. Mary's County, the annual meeting shall be held following
 the first Monday in December; and

9 [(5)] (6) In Washington County, the annual meeting shall be held in 10 December, on or before the 16th day.

11 (c) Except as provided in Title 3 of this article, each county board, at its annual 12 meeting, shall elect a president and a vice president from among its members by means of 13 an individually recorded vote.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2020.
