A BILL

To exclude the imposition of duties and import quotas from the authorities provided to the President under the International Emergency Economic Powers Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Trade Certainty Act
5 of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION OF IMPOSITION OF DUTIES AND IM-**
 2 **PORT QUOTAS FROM PRESIDENTIAL AU-**
 3 **THORITIES UNDER INTERNATIONAL EMER-**
 4 **GENCY ECONOMIC POWERS ACT.**

5 Section 203 of the International Emergency Eco-
 6 nomic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1702) is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
 8 section (d); and

9 (2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
 10 lowing:

11 “(c)(1) The authority granted to the President by
 12 this section does not include the authority to impose duties
 13 or tariff-rate quotas or (subject to paragraph (2)) other
 14 quotas on articles entering the United States.

15 “(2) The limitation under paragraph (1) does not
 16 prohibit the President from excluding all articles, or all
 17 of a certain type of article, imported from a country from
 18 entering the United States.”.

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
