3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Transatlantic Legisla-
- 5 tors' Dialogue Enhancement Act".

6 SEC. 2. TRANSATLANTIC LEGISLATORS' DIALOGUE (UNITED

- 7STATES-EUROPEANUNIONINTER-8PARLIAMENTARY GROUP).
- 9 (a) Establishment and Meetings.—

1	(1) IN GENERAL.—Not to exceed 24 Members
2	of Congress shall be appointed to meet not less than
3	twice annually with representatives of the European
4	Parliament for discussions of common problems in
5	the interest of relations between the United States
6	and the European Union.
7	(2) Reference.—The Members of Congress
8	appointed pursuant to paragraph (1) shall be re-
9	ferred to as the "United States Delegation" of the
10	Transatlantic Legislators' Dialogue (United States-
11	European Union Interparliamentary Group).
12	(b) Appointment and Members.—Of the Members
13	of Congress appointed for purposes of this section—
14	(1) half shall be appointed by the Speaker of
15	the House of Representatives, in consultation with
16	the minority leader of the House, from among Mem-
17	bers of the House (not less than 4 of whom shall be
18	members of the Committee on Foreign Affairs); and
19	(2) half shall be appointed by the President Pro
20	Tempore of the Senate, upon recommendations of
21	the majority and minority leaders of the Senate,
22	from among Members of the Senate (not less than
23	4 of whom shall be members of the Committee on
24	Foreign Relations) unless the majority and minority
25	leaders of the Senate determine otherwise.

(c) Chairperson and Ranking Member.—

2 (1) HOUSE.—The Chair and Vice Chair of the
3 House Group shall be designated by the Speaker of
4 the House of Representatives, in consultation with
5 the minority leader of the House.

6 (2) SENATE.—The President Pro Tempore of 7 the Senate shall designate the Chair or Vice Chair 8 of the Senate group of the United States Delegation. 9 (d) REPORT.—The United States group shall submit 10 to the Congress a report for each fiscal year for which 11 an appropriation is made for the United States Delega-12 tion, which shall include its expenditures under such ap-13 propriation.
