A BILL

To temporarily modify the John H. Chafee Foster Care Program for Successful Transition to Adulthood in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. TEMPORARY MODIFICATIONS TO THE JOHN H.
2	CHAFEE FOSTER CARE PROGRAM FOR SUC-
3	CESSFUL TRANSITION TO ADULTHOOD IN RE-
4	SPONSE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.
5	(a) Increase in Funding.—
6	(1) Generally.—The dollar amount specified
7	in section 477(h)(1) of the Social Security Act for
8	fiscal year 2020 is deemed to be $$283,000,000$ —
9	(A) of which \$140,000,000 shall be avail-
10	able for the purpose described in section
11	477(a)(4) of such Act; and
12	(B) the remainder of which shall be avail-
13	able as provided in such section $477(h)(1)$.
14	(2) Education and training vouchers.—
15	The dollar amount specified in section 477(h)(2) of
16	the Social Security Act for fiscal year 2020 is
17	deemed to be \$120,000,000—
18	(A) of which \$60,000,000 shall be avail-
19	able for the purpose described in section
20	477(a)(5) of such Act; and
21	(B) the remainder of which shall be avail-
22	able as provided in such section $477(h)(2)$.
23	(b) Inapplicability of State Matching Re-
24	QUIREMENT TO ADDITIONAL FUNDS.—
25	(1) In general.—In making payments under
26	section 474(a)(4) of the Social Security Act from the

- additional funds, the percentage specified in section
- 474(a)(4)(A)(i) of such Act is deemed to be 100 per-
- 3 cent.
- 4 (2) Additional funds defined.—In para-
- 5 graph (1) of this subsection, the term "additional
- funds" means the amounts deemed by subsection (a)
- 7 to be specified in each of paragraphs (1) and (2) of
- 8 section 477(h) of the Social Security Act, to the ex-
- 9 tent the amount involved exceeds the amount speci-
- 10 field in the respective paragraph without regard to
- subsection (a) of this section.
- 12 (c) Full and Expeditious Disbursement of
- 13 Funds.—The Secretary of Health and Human Services
- 14 shall fully disburse the amounts payable to States under
- 15 section 474(a)(4) of the Social Security Act, and the
- 16 amounts payable to Indian tribes, tribal organizations,
- 17 and tribal consortia under section 477(j) of such Act, for
- 18 fiscal year 2020 as expeditiously as possible.
- 19 (d) Maximum Age Limitation on Eligibility for
- 20 Assistance.—During fiscal year 2020, a child may be eli-
- 21 gible for services and assistance under section 477 of the
- 22 Social Security Act until the child attains 26 years of age,
- 23 notwithstanding any contrary certification made under
- 24 such section.

- 1 (e) Elimination of Limitation on Housing Ex-
- 2 PENDITURES.—Section 477(b)(3)(B) of the Social Secu-
- 3 rity Act shall have no force or effect with respect to fiscal
- 4 year 2020.
- 5 (f) Elimination of Voucher Work and Edu-
- 6 CATION REQUIREMENTS AND TIME LIMIT.—Section
- 7 477(i)(3) of the Social Security Act shall have no force
- 8 or effect during fiscal year 2020.

9 SEC. 2. MEDICAID OUTREACH.

- The agency of each State that is responsible for ad-
- 11 ministering the State plan approved under part E of title
- 12 IV of the Social Security Act, in consultation with such
- 13 other agencies as are appropriate or interested, shall es-
- 14 tablish and conduct an outreach program designed to in-
- 15 crease the enrollment of individuals who are eligible for
- 16 medical assistance under the State plan approved under
- 17 title XIX of such Act by reason of section
- 18 1902(a)(10)(A)(i)(IX) of such Act.

19 SEC. 3. TEMPORARY INCREASE IN FUNDING FOR HUD FAM-

- 20 ILY UNIFICATION PROGRAM.
- In addition to any amounts otherwise made available
- 22 for fiscal year 2020 for the family unification program
- 23 under section 8(x) of the United States Housing Act of
- 24 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(x)), there is authorized to be ap-

- 1 propriated for fiscal year 2020, \$20,000,000 for assist-
- 2 ance under such section.

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
