3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Livestock Protection5 Act of 2019".

1 SEC. 2. DEPREDATION PERMITS FOR BLACK VULTURES.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior, act3 ing through the Director of the United States Fish and
4 Wildlife Service, may issue a depredation permit to a live5 stock farmer, authorizing the taking of a black vulture
6 otherwise prohibited by Federal law during the calving or
7 lambing season—

- 8 (1) if—
- 9 (A) such vulture is found committing dep10 redations on livestock; or

(B) the livestock is located in an area
where depredation by vultures have been known
to occur; and

(2) provided that such taking may only occur if
it is necessary to protect livestock from depredation.
(b) REPORTING.—The Secretary shall require, as a
condition of such a permit, that the holder of such permit
shall report annually to the appropriate State enforcement
agency, as determined by the Secretary, any taking of a
black vulture under the permit.
