A BILL

To block implementation of the Executive Order that restricts individuals from certain countries from entering the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.
- 4 Congress finds the following:
- 5 (1) The Executive Order titled "Protecting the
- 6 Nation From Foreign Terrorist Entry Into the
- 7 United States' violates the Immigration and Nation-
- 8 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.) which states that

- 1 no person can be discriminated against in the
- 2 issuance of an immigrant visa because of the per-
- 3 son's race, sex, nationality, place of birth, or place
- 4 of residence.
- 5 (2) That Executive Order violates the Estab-
- 6 lishment Clause of the First Amendment to the
- 7 United States Constitution and the equal protection
- 8 component of the Due Process Clause of the Fifth
- 9 Amendment to the United States Constitution.

10 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST USE OF FUNDS.

- 11 No funds, resources, or fees made available to the
- 12 Secretary of Homeland Security, or to any other official
- 13 of a Federal agency, by this Act or any other Act for any
- 14 fiscal year, may be used to implement or enforce the Exec-
- 15 utive Order titled "Protecting the Nation From Foreign
- 16 Terrorist Entry Into the United States" signed on March
- 17 6, 2017.
